1. Praise and Worship (vs 9)
2. Pray for God's will (vs 10) He has purposes that we don't see and more important than our circumstances is that His work is done on earth so He might be glorified.
3. Reliance and dependence of God for our needs (vs 11). Pray about our needs but also thank Him that He promised to provide.
4. Repentance (vs 12) Ask forgiveness for sin and if we don't know of sin ask that the Lord would show us
5. Ask for protection from evil. (vs 13). The spiritual battle is real and we need God's help to say no to temptation.
6. To God be the Glory (vs 13). As we pray the focus always remains on the glory of God.
